



K9 Bed Bug Detection

Highly trained dogs are used to inspect your facility for the presence of live bed bugs. The success rate of our inspections is extremely high, but facility preparation is imperative. You must prepare for our arrival using the checklist below.

PREPARING FOR YOUR SEARCH

- Vacuum floors and furniture thoroughly the day before inspection.
- Remove all pets. Also put away all pet food, water, and toys before inspection.
- Remove all room deodorizers, Scented candles and air fresheners at least 12 hours before inspection.
- Close all outside doors and windows at least 1 hour before inspection.
- Make each room as free of clutter as possible. Put all human food, snacks, and treats away; we must have access to all furniture, sofas, beds, etc.
- Reduce the number of people present, where possible.
- Reduce all noise levels, where possible.
- Turn off all air conditioning, fans, heaters and ceiling fans at least 1 hour before inspection.
- No smoking or cooking in the area to be inspected for 2 hours before inspection.
- Remove all sheets and bedding, place box spring upside down on top of mattress prior to inspection.
- Tell us if any pesticide has been applied in the area to be inspected in the last 15 days prior to Detection appointment.
